
















Chart PF1.1.A: Public spending on family benefits in cash, services and tax measures, in per cent of GDP, 2011








Figure 1. Adult skills are high in Sweden Scores in the OECD Survey of Adult Skills¹

Figure 2. Health spending (excluding investment) as a share of GDP, OECD countries, 2013


